Natural/Adabas to Java/SQL migration - this large project is heading in the right direction

Senden, Germany and Denver, CO – November 04, 2011.

The State of Colorado and innoWake are in the middle of migrating a large application from the mainframe in Natural/Adabas to Java/SQL. This is a very innovative project and many obstacles need to be overcome for its final completion in 2 years' time. Wisely a first snapshot of viability was planned to be delivered very early on. A so-called Initial Component Build intends to prove the overall approach taken to this migration project.

After only two months after kick-off, innoWake delivered the ICB as intended and even exceeded expectations. The scope, initially limited to a small section of the application because of the tight timeline, was multiplied and a full online and a full batch process ran without hiccups. With this fully functional sub package the State was able to verify with all affected parties, from end-users through the development team that everyone was getting what they were expecting. The ability to quickly scale the scope also validates the approach of using automation for large systems. There is no lack of excitement about the result. Both innoWake and the State of Colorado are looking forward to the overall completion in 2013.
